- 6 to 8 sparring partners (juniors)

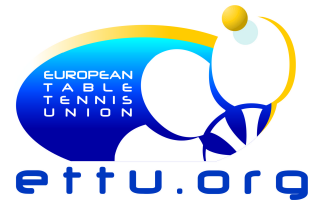
For organising the Women's Coaching Seminar and the Annual Coaching Conference, it is necessary to provide:

- Three-star hotel accommodation
- Conference hall with 50 to 60 places, with equipment for presentations
- Small table tennis hall with a minimum of 2 tables
- Organized local transport for participants

- - Accommodation prices up to EUR 55,-
- - Organized local transport

In addition to this, some younger players from the before-mentioned generation will be invited to our new project U-18 (those players have been evaluated by: Li Xiaodong, Xia Cheng, Istvan Korpa and Neven Cegnar).

With regard to all other young players from the generation of 2014 who are not invited, they will have the possibility to improve their quality and results and thus earn their place in the development projects of the European Table Tennis Union.
