

INVITATION TO COACHING CONFERENCE

IN COLLABORATION WITH ETTU

MALMÖ 2023

During the European Table Tennis Team Championships in Malmö, the Swedish Table Tennis Association (STTA) and the European Table Tennis Union (ETTU) extend an invitation to all Member Associations to attend the Coaching Conference at Malmö Arena from September 14th to 16th.

This event will reflect the ETTU's Annual Coaching Conference. Coaching educators and youth national team coaches from Sweden are specially invited and, subject to availability, interested table tennis fans.

The conference starts on Thursday at 12.00 with lunch and will include lectures, workshops, match analysis and observation of live matches according to the schedule below. Lectures are interspersed with workshops to provide the opportunity of exchanging experiences between coaches from different European countries. There will be plenty of time for group discussions to share knowledge between the participants.

The registration fee is 6800 SEK and that includes: entry to the venue, 3 lunches, 2 dinners, transport between the hotel and the venue, accommodation (double occupancy – extra cost 500 SEK/night, if you prefer single occupancy), and refreshments (Swedish “fika”).

- ACCOMODATION:** Hotel Scandic Triangeln.
- REGISTRATION:** Registrations will be received by email to projects@ettu.org and ana.ivošević@ettu.org. The last day of registration is 10th August.
- PAYMENT:** STTA will invoice the respective National Association of each participant coach, and the payment must be taken care of latest 31st August.
- TRAVEL:** Participants will book and pay for their own trips.

ETTU will provide full support (excluding travel expenses) for the conference to Member Associations. This includes the package for one coach in double room per Association. The selection of coaches will be done on a first-come, first-served basis until the quota of 10 coaches is reached. Additional coaches can attend the conference covering the price of the full package.
