Playing system in Team Match -Qualification stage:

A1 v B2 A2 v B1

doubles (can play A1/A2/A3/A4 vs B1/B2//B3/B4

Three matches will be played. The result of the match can be 3:0 or 2:1.

Playing system in Team Match – Final Draw:

Match Order	Team A	VS	Team B	NOTE
Match 1	A1	VS	B2	
Match 2	A2	VS	B1	
Match 3	double	VS	double	can play A1/A2/A3/A4 vs B1/B2B3/B4
Match 4	A1	VS	B1	1 substitution per team is
Match 5	A2	vs	B2	allowed

Match should be played **BEST OF FIVE MATCHES.**





Match Procedure:

A team shall consist of maximum 4 players. Each team shall appoint a playing or non-playing captain, who shall be present throughout a match. A match shall be played on 1 table. Before the match, the captains shall decide by lot the right to choose Team A or Team B and shall nominate their players.

Match Preparation:

There are two phases of Match Preparation:

- 1. Match preparation with team captains
- > Team captains must be in the Call Area **40 minutes** before the scheduled start of the match for the draw (Team A or Team B).
- > Team captain who is <u>late more</u> than <u>5 minutes</u> loses the right to the draw and the opponent can choose between Team A and B.
- ➤ Team captains must fill out <u>immediately</u> the Toss Sheet (Name Team Captain / Coach (in a readable way), composition of the team for the match, colour of the shirts) The order of matches is A1-B2, A2-B1, doubles, A1-B1, A2-B2.
- > Shirts:
 - Colour the team has to be dressed uniformly during the whole team match
 - Players must have their back number on the back of their shirts
 - o both teams must wear shirts in clearly different colours
- 2. Racket inspection and ball selection
- Players must bring their rackets 15 minutes before the scheduled time to the Call Area. Players who are to play second, third have to bring their rackets latest just before the previous individual match starts. However, it would be desirable if all rackets were handed in 15 minutes in advance.
- ➤ Ball selection each team has to choose **2 balls** for the team match (no multiball)


During the Team Match:

- > On each table, the use of maximum one camera per team is allowed to record their own match.
- ➤ Team Bench = 3 seats
- Medical staff, physios are not allowed on the Team Bench; they are sitting on dedicated seats behind the bench, <u>not</u> moving them anywhere
