System of play

- Matches in singles Qualification Stage shall be best of five (5) games.
- Matches in singles Main Draw shall be best of seven (7) games.
- All doubles and mixed doubles matches shall be best of five (5) games

Call Area

Athletes shall meet the officials in the Call Area 20 min before the scheduled starting time of the match.

Athletes shall be in the presentation area 8 min before the scheduled starting time of the match

Clothing

Before the match the players should bring and show their match T shirt. (ITTF Regulation)

PRINTED NAMES ON THE T SHIRT

Players shall have their names printed on the back of their T shirts.

Players failing to compete with a t-shirt including their name printed on the back shall receive a fine of €100 for each match played without a printed name

PRINTED ADVERTISEMENTS ON PLAYING CLOTHING

ETTU shall adapt the ITTF player clothing advertising regulations to restrict to the following commercial advertisements:

- (1) one clothing manufacturer's brand,
- (4) four commercial brands.

OFFICIAL RACKET CONTROL

Rackets not presented before the match will always be tested after the match in the RCC, with the risk of loss of the match. Players may collect their rackets at the RCC 10 min later.



Name of the advisor

- ✓ Only one coach is allowed
- ✓ Where a doubles pair consists of players from different Associations, each may nominate an adviser



Ball selection

Up to 2 balls each player/pair




Practice between matches on a free table
