Playing system singles

- Stage 1: 48 players plays in 12 groups. Winner and runner up qualifies for Stage 2
- Stage 2: 24 qualifiers from stage 1 and seeded 1 8 plays in 8 groups. Winner and runner up qualifies for Stage 3.
- Stage 3: 16 players play a direct knock-out tournament.
- All singles matches will be best of 7 games.

Playing system doubles

- All doubles events will be played in a direct knock-out competition.
- Doubles matches will be best of 5 games.
- Doubles pair may be formed by players from different associations.







Call area:

During this tournament a call area is set up. Its functions are as follows

- Racket testing
- Check of the colour of the shirts that are brought by the players before their next match
- Ball selection
- The indicated time-limits below (clothing, racket deposit and control, ball choice) are to be strictly observed; no exceptions will be made.







Procedures in the call area

General

- Players shall meet the officials 20 minutes before the match in the Call Area
- Players shall be in the presentation area 6 minutes before the scheduled starting time of the match.

Shirts

- Before the match the players shall bring and show their match T shirt.
- Players shall have their names printed on the back of their shirts. Players failing to compete with a T-shirt including their name printed of the back shall receive a fine of 100 EUR for each match played without their printed name.
- o The 2 players must wear shirts of clearly different main colours
- o Main colour will be registered on the score sheet
- o The player, who did not present the shirt in the call area, must immediately change the shirt in case of a colour clash.







· Racket Testing

- The players have the right to deposit their next-match racket at the Call Area 20 minutes before their match of the next round.
- Umpires will perform the racket inspection in the call area/racket control room
- o The racket will be kept in the Call Area and the umpire of the match will hand the racket to the players at the table.
- o Rackets not brought to the Call Area before the match:
 - will be tested afterwards (after match test) with the risk of loss of the match
 - The umpire will be informed about the after match-test and will only check any other irregularities (are the racket coverings damaged) at the table.

· Ball selection

- o Each player/pair may choose 2 balls during their meeting with the officials in the Call Area.
- o If no player/pair selects balls, the umpire will select balls in the Call Area.

Coach/advisor

- Players have to add the name of their advisor on the scoresheet.
- Only one advisor is allowed except from where a doubles pair consists of players from different Associations, each player may nominate an adviser.







Practice

No practice is allowed between matches in the main hall. Practice is referred to the Practice Hall.

Advice

- o A player or pair may receive advice only from one person, designated beforehand to the Umpire.
- o Players may receive advice at any time except during rallies provided that continuity of play is not affected;
- o If an unauthorised person gives advice the Umpire shall hold up a red card and send him away.
- o If any authorised person gives advice in a way the continuity of play is affected the umpire will hold up a yellow card to warn the advisor that any further such offence will result in his or her's dismissal from the playing area.

Cameras/Video

- o Each player is allowed to use one video camera for recording his/her matches.
- Video is only for own use meaning that it is not permitted to distribute and share the video or post online.
