## **COACHES:**

**Petr KORBEL**, a Czech table tennis player who has competed in five Olympics from 1992 to 2008. His best performance was in 1996 when he came fourth in singles. He is a Butterfly contracted player and cooperated on the development of a table tennis blade which has been produced under his name.

**Tomas DEMEK**, Head Coach of TTC Ostrava 2016 (member of Table Tennis Champions League Men, Czech Team Champion 2014 – 2017), many years National Coach of the Czech Men's Team (5th place at the World Team Table Tennis Championships 2008, 3rd place at the European Championships 2010). National Coach of the Czech Cadets Team (from 2018).

Iveta Vacenovska, a Czech table tennis player who has competed in two Olympics from 2012 to 2016. Her best performance was quartefinal on World Championships in singles and she won gold medal in singles on European Youth Championships in juniors.

Ostrava - The metropolis of the Moravian-Silesian region the second largest city in the Czech Republic and has the third largest population. It has got a very advantageous strategic position - it is located about 10 kilometres south of the Polish border and 50 kilometres west of the Slovak border. The distance from Ostrava to Praha is 360 km, to Brno 170 km, to the Polish City of Katowice 90 km, and to Vienna 310 km. There are the rivers of Odra, Ostravice, Opava, and Lučina flowing through the city.
