## **REPORT TO THE 2010 CONGRESS in Ostrava**

This report relates to the period between ETTU Congress in Stuttgart and Congress in Ostrava.

During the mentioned period I took part in the exchange of opinions between members of ETTU Executive Board per e-mails or telephone, including one telephone conference.

Particular part of my interest was the task given by ETTU Congress in Stuttgart and President himself to be a member of Working Group for creating the structure of future European Championships. This task took a lot of my time and efforts and hopefully paid off by final product, the draft, which has been produced and exposed to the table tennis public opinion (officials, coaches, players, journalists).

In the execution of the task, many letters have been exchanged between 10 members of WG and at the end, small "task force" consisted from General Secretary J.Dom, Deputy President E. Scholer and two Vice President, C. Gonderinger and myself had obligation to put all ideas and proposals into the frame. One meeting of this small group (apart of many e-mails and telephone exchange) in Frankfurt April 13<sup>th</sup> was dedicated to this issue. My thanks go to all three of them for friendly collaboration and dedication to the success of our work and to all others who contributed with their views and ideas.

In November 2009 I attended the match Europe – Asia in Istanbul, using this opportunity to meet with players, officials of Turkish Federation and to discuss with ETTU Competition manager some problems concerning future European Championships in Istanbul 2010.

At the end of November 2009 I was attending ETTU Coaching Conference in Zagreb, using the opportunity to speak with distinguished coaches about many problems, especially about future structure of European Championships.

In mentioned period Executive Board gathered in Dusseldorf during Europe Top 12 (February 5<sup>th</sup> 2010) and twice in Moscow during World Team Championships (May 24<sup>th</sup> and May 27<sup>th</sup> 2010) and I attended all three of them, trying to give some contribution in accordance with the best of my abilities.

Communication with ETTU office in Luxembourg was perfect one, due to expertise of Miss Dom, General Secretary and good will of Mr. Pierre Kass, the Assistant of G.S. and my thanks go to both of them.
