1. SCHEDULE

• 17/12/23 Arrival day and meeting with coaches.

18/12/23 – 22/12/23 Training camp.
23/12/23 Departure day.

2. ORGANISER

Hennebont Ping Center (FRA) in cooperation with ETTU.

3. PARTICIPATION CRITERIA

Each Association may nominate four (4) players in total (2 U-15 players and 2 U-17 players). As the number of participants for the camp is limited spots will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Depending on the number of associations entering players ETTU could fill empty places in cooperation with the organiser (Hennebont Ping Center).

4. ACCOMODATION and FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

The accommodation price of the accommodation costs (including food - 3 meals per day) is of **80 € per person per day** on basis of a double or triple room occupancy.

Single rooms for coaches are very limited and may be available on request for the additional price of $20 \in \text{per person}$ and per day.

ETTU will pay a subsidy for accommodation costs for 1 player U-15 and 1 player U-17 from each Member Association — 50 € / day/player.

- Transportation from/to Lorient train station (accessible from Paris in 3 hours): free

12.EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITY

A session about cyberbullying prevention with the players is scheduled on Wednesday 30th December at 2 pm in the Hennebont Ping Center.
