Dear friends from all ***European Table Tennis Associations***,

The European Table Tennis Union has the great pleasure to invite International Umpires (preference given to Gold / Blue Badge umpires) for officiating at the

2022 European Championships (individual) 13th– 21st of August 2022, in Munich (GER)

The organizer offers free hospitality in a single room from dinner on Friday 12th of August to breakfast

- on Thursday 18th of August for selected umpires 13.08.2022 – 17.08.2022;
- on Saturday 20th of August for selected umpires 13.08.2022 – 19.08.2022;
- on Monday 22nd of August for selected umpires 13.08.2022 – 21.08.2022.

The organizer will provide transport from Munich International Airport (MUC) and Munich Central Train Station to the venue and return free of charge.

The daily allowance will be:

- Gold / Blue Badge umpires shall receive a daily allowance of
 - 60 EURO for 13.-16.08.2022
 - 100 EURO for 17.-21.08.2022
- Other match officials shall receive an allowance of 60 EURO for each working day.

Flights will be paid for final day umpires (4 foreign umpires)

The nominees (except final day umpires) or their Associations are responsible for all related travel and insurance costs. Please note that by submitting a nomination, the Association confirms its responsibility to ensure the nominee has sufficient financial support for airfare.

The application shall arrive **until 30th of April, 12 pm** at urc@ettu.org

Only applications on the **attached form** and submitted by the Association will be considered.

The selection will be made before 15th of May and the umpires will be informed immediately after. Selected umpires may not be replaced by the Associations concerned except with the prior authorization of the ETTU URC.

COVID-19

The welfare of players, coaches, officials, staff, volunteers and everyone working and attending the European Competitions are of the utmost importance and priority. ETTU and the German Table Tennis Association are completing the Hygienic Guidelines taking advice from the German Government and liaising with ITTF in terms of WHO (World Health Organization) recommendations. The Hygienic Guidelines will be released as soon as there is further information and all elements of the event have

been considered including transport, hotels, venue, court and table cleaning, training hall and call area requirements, etc.

Due to the Covid-19 situation, selected umpires will be informed as soon as possible but will have to wait for the ETTU green light before to book the transportation tickets.
