



TTCL Men - Licensing Regulations 2016/2017

The following Licensing Regulations must be agreed by the clubs. The clubs must be able to fulfill the following requirements for being accepted to take part in the competition.

The participating clubs of the TTCLM season 2016/17 need to:

- be able to play the TTCLM matches on weekdays
- provide a stable internet connection of minimum 3Mbit/s upload for their home matches
- provide an international high quality TV signal for the semi-finals and finals (home matches)
- set up a court layout with 36 A-boards for their home matches
- provide a camera position so that also the backside of the competition table is visible for their home matches (Figure 1 acts as an example the mandatory criteria is that the backside of the table is visible)


