## Playing system

### MIXED TEAM EVENT

Team composition : each team consists of 2 boys and 2 girls			
Match order	Team A	Team B	Note
Match 1	XD	XD	restriction
Match 2	Girl	Girl	Boys not playing XD
Match 3	Boy	Boy	Girls not playing XD
Match 4	Girl	Girl	Boys playing XD match
Match 5	Boy	Boy	Girls playing XD match

In the group stage all five matches shall be played

All matches are played best of 5 games, in all stages of the competition.

## Procedures

### Call area:

During this tournament a call area is set up. Its functions are as follows

- Racket testing
- Check of the colour of the shirts that are brought by the players before their next match
- Ball selection

### Procedures in the call area

#### Draw for team events:

- 60 m before the start of the match – toss
- 25 m Singles/doubles event

#### Shirt Colour

- 60 (T)/25 (I) minutes before the match the players should show their match shirt.
- The 2 players/teams must wear shirts of clearly different main colours
- The player/team, who did not present the shirt in the call area, must immediately change the shirt in case of a colour clash.

#### Racket Testing

- The players have the right to deposit their next-match racket at the call area 25 minutes before their match of the next round.
- **In team events** the team can decide to deposit rackets of all players before the start of the match or decide that each player deposits his own racket before his individual match. (**30 minutes before**)
- Umpires will perform the racket inspection in the call area/
- The racket will be kept in the call area and the umpire of the match will hand the racket to the players at the table.
- Rackets not being forwarded to the call area before the match
  - will be tested afterwards (after match test).
  - The umpire will be informed about the after match-test and will only check any other irregularities (are the racket coverings damaged) at the table.

#### Ball selection

- Each team may choose 2 balls for team event – 30 m before match starting time
- Each player may choose 2 balls for singles/doubles event
- If no player selects a ball, the umpire will decide

#### Coach

- Team event – 2 coaches
- Singles – one coach
- Players have to add the name of their adviser on the scoresheet
