PLAYING CONDITIONS:

New playing hall, air conditioned, equipped with 30 Tibhar tables. Tibhar white balls will be used for the camp. Further to the head coach, there will be 8 assistant coaches. Room for coaches and players with water will be available at all times.

TRANSPORT:

ARRIVAL – DEPARTURES

The city of Kiskunfelegyhaza is situated about 110 km south east of Budapest. There are direct trains from Budapest airport to Kiskunfelegyhaza almost every hour.

All participants travelling by air are requested to arrive in Budapest. The delegations will be welcomed at the airport. A shuttle train runs between Liszt Ferenc Budapest airport and Kiskunfélegyháza at one hour intervals.

For those coming by car (M5 Highway, direction 110KM south of Budapest) there are two possible exists, both lead to Kiskunfélegyháza City Centre.

EXTRA ACTIVITIES & FACILITIES:
