2. Authority

The Czech Table Tennis Association under the authority of the European Table Tennis Union (ETTU) shall organise the European Youth Table Tennis Championships.

6. Eligibility

The Championships shall be open for entry to all member Associations whose subscriptions are not in arrears. All players must be eligible to represent their Associations in accordance with the provisions of article ETTU Regulation (B) B.10.3.3 of the ETTU Handbook.

Junior players shall be under 18 years of age and cadet players shall be under 15 years of age on the 31st December immediately before the start of the year in which the Championships take place (junior players born on or after 01.01.2001, cadet players born on or after 01.01.2004).

A cadet who competes in a junior event may not compete in the corresponding cadet event.

8. Consolation events

Consolation events will be organised for the players defeated in the qualifying stage and in the first round of the singles events. The entry fee in consolation event is 5 EUR and has to be paid in advance.

9. Entries

Associations may enter only 1 team in each team event.

The Organising Association shall be entitled to enter up to 20 players, consisting of not more than 6 players participating in junior boys singles, doubles and mixed doubles, 6 players participating in junior girls singles, doubles and mixed doubles, 4 players participating in cadet boys events and mixed doubles, 4 players participating in cadet girls events and mixed doubles, but may not enter more than 5 players participating in junior boys team and 5 players participating in junior girls team.

Each other Association shall be entitled to enter up to 18 players, consisting of not more than 5 players participating in junior boys' events and mixed doubles, 5 players participating in junior girls' events and mixed doubles, 4 players participating in cadet boys' events and mixed doubles, 4 players participating in cadet girls' events and mixed doubles.

10. Entry fee

The entry fee paid to the Organising Association shall be 40 € for each participating Association and there shall be a levy of 125 € on each Association participating in a team event, payable to the ETTU.

11. Preliminary entries

Preliminary Entries have to be addressed to the Organising Association CTTA: ctta@cusc.cz by using the attached form (with a copy to the ETTU Secretariat: ettu@pt.lu) and the Competition Manager: dmessinis@ittf.com) not later than Sunday 21st April 2019.

12. Entry deadlines

All entries must be duly completed and submitted to the ETTU before the deadline dates. ETTU accepts only online entries by using National Association's Log-in (<https://www.ttm.co.at/onlineentries>).

Final entries

Final entries must be submitted on the ETTU online entry system by providing all necessary information. In order to go through the entry process successfully, each field has to be completed properly. Final entries will be open on Monday 22nd April 2019 and closed on Monday 27th May 2019.

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Important:

Please note that after the final deadline, no additional player will be accepted. Only changes or cancellations are accepted in case of all accredited persons. These modifications can be done online up to and including Tuesday 2nd July 2019 with the possibility to complete, by the Secretary General, up to the first jury meeting, a team, in case of illness or injury according to ETTU Handbook D.7.3.1.

13. The Draw

The draw for team events will take place in Brussels on Wednesday 5th June.

The draw for individual events shall take place during the playing of the team events.

Seeding for team events shall be based on the current World Rankings for juniors and cadets and in addition on the total number of ranking points for the 3 (juniors) or 2 (cadets) entered and highest ranked players per team.

Seeding for the individual events shall be based on the current World Rankings for juniors and cadets. The Ranking Committee may give special seeding positions to players not having competed at a minimum of five (5) competitions within the appropriate age group. The National Association of the player must send a written request to the Competition Manager and to the ETTU Ranking Committee within three (3) days after the final entry deadline.

For the seeding of doubles pairs, additional points may be given to players or pairs with good results in doubles during the current season.

14. System of play

System of play in team events will be according to ETTU Handbook D.11, except that in the junior team events the losing semi-finalists will play a World Junior Qualification Match. The winner of this match qualifies for the team event of the World Junior Championships 2019. In cadet team events, a match to determine positions 3 and 4 will not be played.

System of play in individual events will be according to ETTU Handbook D.12.

15. Trophies/Awards

Plaques shall be presented to the winners of team and individual events.

In addition, medals shall be presented to all members, including non-playing captains, of teams placed 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in team events and to winners, runners-up and losing semi-finalists of individual events.

There shall be no plaques, medals or presentations for consolation events.

20. Hospitality

The Organising Association shall provide 50% of the cost of hospitality (on the basis of the price for a double room) from the evening on Saturday 6th July until the morning on Wednesday 17th July, for up to:

- up to 6 players of an Association entering at least 2 junior teams or 1 junior team and 2 cadet teams;
- up to 5 players of an Association entering 1 junior team and 1 cadet team;
- up to 4 players of an Association entering 2 cadet teams;
- up to 3 players of an Association entering 1 junior team;
- up to 2 players of an Association entering only 1 cadet team or only individual players;
- up to 2 officials of an Association entering 4 teams;
- 1 official only of any other Association entering teams or players.

The Organising Association shall provide free hospitality from dinner on Saturday 6th July until breakfast on Wednesday 17th July for the Executive Board members, the Press and the Medical Officials or their deputies, the Chairs of the Youth and Ranking Committees, up to 4 Youth Committee members and 3 ETTU staff members and invited foreign umpires.

The Organising Association shall provide free hospitality from Friday 5th July until on Wednesday 17th July for the referee and all foreign deputy referees plus the referee's travel expenses.

Full hospitality rate (per day) for persons not entitled to free hospitality:

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Important:

Please note that an entering association can cancel a person of its announced delegation till Thursday 5th July 2018 paying the amount of 100 Euro per person as cancellation fee (ETTU Handbook D.8.1.8.1). After this deadline the entering association will be charged 100% of the total hospitality amount for each missing person and for the whole period initially nominated as cancellation fee according to the ETTU Handbook D.8.1.8.2.

Note: The participation of the players at the EYC is not allowed without payment in advance by bank transfer or cash at the accreditation.

23. Transport

The Organiser will provide transport from Ostrava Airport and Ostrava Railway station to the venue of the EYC and return free of charge.

The Organiser will provide transport from Katowice Airport (Poland) to the venue of the EYC and return for 30 Euro per person (return journey).

The Organiser will provide transport from Krakow Airport (Poland) to the venue of the EYC and return for 40 Euro per person (return journey).

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The deadline to submit the travel details on the ETTU online entries system is set on Friday 7th June.

24. Medical service

Permanent medical service (first aid) will be provided in the hall during the whole period of the Championships. However, we strongly recommend to each delegation to have medical insurance.

25. Racket Control

There will be random racket tests.

26. Video

Each participating Association will be allowed to use one video camera for recording matches of their own players. For using another video camera, a fee of 20 EUR shall be paid for the whole EYC period.
