It is entirely the players' responsibility to declare their prize money received as required according to and in the respect of the national laws of their country of residence. The prize money will be paid on site cash to each player in Euro; the taxes respecting the Swiss laws will be deducted based on the official exchange rate between Euro and Swiss Francs on Sunday 3rd February 2019.

#### 8. Playing system

The competition is played on a knockout basis and in addition the losers of the semi-finals will play a match to determine places 3 and 4. All matches will be played best of 7 games.

The tournament shall be played in accordance with the Laws of Table Tennis and the Regulations for International Competitions.

#### 10. Ranking Default Policy

Ranking Default Policy applies for the tournament - ITTF World Ranking Regulations 2019, paragraphs 6 Late Cancellation and 7 Ranking penalties at ITTF Sanctioned competitions.

The draw will be on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> February 2019 commencing at 19.00 local time in the Fairmont Le Montreux Palace Hotel.

#### 12. Draw procedure

The seeding list will be made according to the latest published World Ranking.

Seeded players 1 and 2 will be placed in position 1 and 16.

Seeded players 3 and 4 will be drawn by lot into position 8 and 9.

Seeded players 5 to 8 will be drawn by lot into positions 4, 5, 12, 13.

All remaining players will be drawn randomly to positions 2, 3, 6, 7, 10, 11, 14 and 15. There shall be no separation by Association.

#### 13. Participants

There shall be 16 players per gender qualified for the ITTF Europe Top 16 Cup.

- a) The current European Champion.
- b) The top 14 players from the December 2018 European Ranking List excluding the current European Champion, or top 15 players if a Host Association player qualifies.
- c) If no players qualify from the Host Association then the Host Association shall nominate one Host Association player.

There shall be no more than 2 players per gender from an Association.

All players have to be eligible to represent their national Association according to the rules 3.8 and 4.3.6 of the ITTF Handbook 2018 (eligibility at World title events).

#### 14. Participation confirmation

Invitation confirmation deadline is Monday 17<sup>th</sup> December 2018.

#### 15. Substitutions

Substitutions before the entry closing date shall be as per entry regulations and according to December 2018 European Ranking List.

- a) If the European Champion is not available or withdraws, he/she shall be replaced by the remaining highest ranked player from the European ranking.
- b) If the Host Association player is not available or withdraws, another player nominated by the Host Association shall replace him/her.
- c) If any other player is not available or withdraws, he shall be replaced by the remaining highest ranked player.

Substitutions after the entry closing date shall be decided by the ETTU.

#### 16. Draw and Press Conference

#### It is the obligation of ALL players to attend the draw.

Furthermore, all players will be required to attend a personal interview on site if requested. For event and player promotion including photos and social media content, players must be available on Friday (any activity would be max. 1 hour) around practice plans / schedule. If any extra ETTU activity is
