A meeting for all coaches will be held on Sunday, **2nd February at 20:00.**

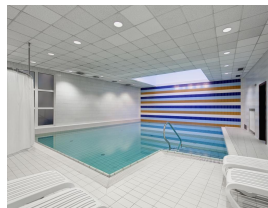
ACCOMMODATION: Imperial Hotel Ostrava ****

TRANSPORT:

Ostrava - [The metropolis of the Moravian-Silesian region](#) the second largest city in the Czech Republic and has the third largest population. It has got a very advantageous strategic position - it is located about 10 kilometres south of the Polish border and 50 kilometres west of the Slovak border. The distance from Ostrava to Praha is 360 km, to Brno 170 km, to the Polish City of Katowice 90 km, and to Vienna 310 km. There are the rivers of Odra, Ostravice, Opava, and Lučina flowing through the city.

All participants **travelling by air** are requested to arrive either in Ostrava Airport (Czech Rep.), or Katowice Airport (Poland), or Krakow Airport (Poland). The delegations will be welcomed at the airport. Transfer from/to Ostrava Airport (cca 25 min. by car) may be organized upon request free of charge. Transfer from/to Katowice Airport (cca 1 hour by car) may be organized at extra costs upon request (15 € per person one way). Transfer from/to Krakow Airport (cca 1,5 hour by car) may be organized at extra costs upon request (25 € per person, one way).

All participants **travelling by train** are requested to arrive in Ostrava Main Station (Czech Rep.), it's only five minutes by car or seven minutes by tram. Transfer from/to railway stations Ostrava (Ostrava – Svinov or Ostrava Main Station) may be organized upon request free of charge.

Cancellation of participants is possible till: **26 January 2020**.
For cancellation after 26 January 2020, **CANCELLATION FEE of EUR 120,- will be charged.**

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS:

ETTU will cover full board and lodging for all nominated players and one coach / national association in double occupancy.

It is possible to enter other players provided there is enough place in the camp – to be confirmed by the organisers after entry.

It is extremely important that invited players attend the camp with their national team and/or personal coaches as this is the best opportunity to discuss future programmes for the players and establish regular communication among coaches and adequate ETTU bodies. The ETTU is also keen to increase the number of female coaches in Europe and therefore encourage the participation of female coaches. This is a great training opportunity for both male and female coaches to learn and grow together with the young players.
